CLUMPING SPECIES (non-invasive)

- \$22 **BAMBUSA ARNHEIMICA**. Australia. 12m x 10cm. 0°C. A green culmed, small leafed native used for didgeridoo making etc. Edible shoots.
- \$22 **BAMBUSA BAMBOOS (Giant Thorny Bamboo)**. India. 30m x 20cm. -2°C. One of the largest bamboos. Thorny.
- \$55 **BAMBUSA BONIOPSIS**. China. 4m x 2cm. -7°C. A nice garden bamboo with a bushy, slightly weeping appearance. Good pot plant.
- \$44 **BAMBUSA CHUNGII (White Bamboo)**. China. 10m x 6cm. -4°C. Erect. Thin walled. A beautiful ornamental with white bloom covered culms.
- \$55 **BAMBUSA DOLICHOMERITHALLA**. Taiwan. 10m x 5cm. -2°C. Straight light green culms with dark green striations which yellow with age.
- \$55 **BAMBUSA DOLICHOMERITHALLA cv. 'SILVERSTRIPE'**. Taiwan. 10m x 5cm. -2°C. Straight dark green culms with silver striations.
- \$33 **BAMBUSA EUTULDOIDES**. China. 12m x 5cm. -9°C. Very dense, straight near solid culms.
- \$77 **BAMBUSA EUTULDOIDES var. VIRIDI VITTATA (China Gold)**. China. 6m x 4cm. -9°C. Lemon yellow culms with green striations and yellow striations on the leaves. Culms are upright with branchy lower sections, making it a great screening or feature bamboo.
- \$22 **BAMBUSA HETEROSTACHYA**. Malaysia. 6m x 5cm. -2°C. Forms a dense canopy 4-5m up with its weeping culms. A very fast grower.
- \$22 **BAMBUSA HETEROSTACHYA cv. VARIEGATED (Malay Dwarf Variegated)**. Malaysia. 3m x 2.5cm. -2°C. A beautiful dense bushy ornamental with cream striped leaves. Makes a great screen or controllable hedge. Small birds love it for nesting. A very fast grower.
- \$33 **BAMBUSA GUANGXIENSIS (Chinese Dwarf)**. China. 3m x 1cm. -4°C. An incredibly lush and bushy bamboo. Excellent pot plant, small privacy screen or feature.
- \$44 **BAMBUSA INDIGENA**. China. 5m x 4cm. -2°C. A fairly dense bamboo, used as windbreaks. Good timber.
- \$33 **BAMBUSA LAKO (Timor Black)**. Indonesia. 20m x 10cm. -3°C. Very attractive. Black culms with green stripes.
- \$33 **BAMBUSA LONGISPICULATA**. India. 18m x 10cm. -2°C. Straight ivory striped culms. Very open clumping.
- \$22 **BAMBUSA MACULATA (Pring Tutul)**. Indonesia. 20m x 12cm. -3°C. Green culms with cream stripes. High quality furniture timber.
- \$22 **BAMBUSA MALINGENSIS**. China. 12m x 5cm. -7°C. Dense clumps, erect culms, tolerates sea breeze better than most.
- \$22 **BAMBUSA MULTIPLEX (Hedge Bamboo)**. China. 7m x 3cm. -12°C. Good windbreaker. Prone to sooty mould in warm, humid climates.
- \$22 **BAMBUSA MULTIPLEX cv. 'ALBO STRIATA'**. China. 6m x 4cm. -12°C. Green culms with white striation. Erect. Edible shoots.
- \$22 **BAMBUSA MULTIPLEX cv. 'ALPHONSE KARR'**. China. 7m x 3cm. -12°C. Yellow culms with green stripes. Edible shoots.
- \$22 **BAMBUSA MULTIPLEX cv. 'GOLDSTRIPE'**. China. 5m x 2cm. -12°C. A nice upright, tight clumping beauty. Golden stripes on the culms.
- \$22 **BAMBUSA MULTIPLEX cv. 'GOLDEN GODDESS'**. 4m x 1.5cm. -12°C. Culms turn golden with sun exposure.
- \$22 **BAMBUSA MULTIPLEX cv. 'SILVERSTRIPE'**. China. 7m x 3cm. -12°C. White stripes on culms & leaves. Edible.
- \$22 **BAMBUSA MULTIPLEX cv. 'STRIPESTEM FERNLEAF'**. 4m x 1.5cm. -12°C. Yellow/pink culms with green stripes.
- \$22 **BAMBUSA 'NEW GUINEA BLACK'**. New Guinea. 6m x 5cm. -2°C. Green with cream striations which age to mottled black.
- \$33 **BAMBUSA NUTANS**. China. 10m x 8cm. -5°C. A very nice garden bamboo with straight strong culms and edible shoots.
- \$22 **BAMBUSA OLDHAMII**. China. 18m x 10cm. -9°C. Very fast grower which makes excellent windbreaks. Grown commercially for its edible shoots. (Discount available on commercial quantities).
- \$44 **BAMBUSA OLIVERIANA**. Burma. 10m x 5cm. -2°C. Dense, tight clumping ornamental with small leaves.
- \$22 **BAMBUSA POLYMORPHA**. Burma. 5m x 5cm -3°C. Near solid culms.
- \$33 **BAMBUSA TEXTILIS (Weaver's Bamboo)**. China. 12m x 5cm. -12°C. Straight, branch free lower half with long internodes.
- \$33 **BAMBUSA TEXTILIS var. FASCA**. China. 12m x 5cm. -12°C. Same as B. Textilis but with brown hair on culm sheaths.
- \$33 **BAMBUSA TEXTILIS var. GLABRA**. China. 10m x 5cm. -12°C. Same as B. Textilis but with smooth, hairless culms.
- \$33 **BAMBUSA TEXTILIS var. GRACILIS (Slender Weaver's Bamboo)**. China. 8m x 3cm. -12°C. Straight, thin walled. Very ornamental.
- \$44 **BAMBUSA TULDA (Bengal Bamboo)**. India. 25m x 8cm. -2°C. Very strong timber.
- \$44 **BAMBUSA TULDOIDES (Punt Pole Bamboo)**. China. 17m x 5cm. -9°C. Excellent timber.
- \$22 **BAMBUSA VARIOSTRIATA**. China. 10m x 5cm. -4°C. A green bamboo with striped basal nodes and fernlike leaves.
- \$33 **BAMBUSA VENTRICOSA (Buddha's Belly)**. China. 17m x 10cm. -9°C. Under harsh conditions it develops short swollen internodes.
- \$33 **BAMBUSA VENTRICOSA KIMMEI**. China. 17m x 10cm. -9°C. As above but with yellow/green striated culms and cream striped leaves.
- \$22 **BAMBUSA VULGARIS**. Madagascar? 24m x 15cm. -2°C. Most common bamboo in the world. Very adaptive. Good rainforest pioneer.
- \$22 **BAMBUSA VULGARIS cv. 'VITTATA' (Painted Bamboo)**. origin? 15mx12cm -2°C. Lemon yellow culms with green stripes. Open clumping.
- \$22 **BAMBUSA VULGARIS cv. 'WAMIN' (Giant Buddha's Belly)**. China. 5m x 12cm. -2°C. Large swollen internodes and weeping culms. A spectacular ornamental. Fairly open clumping. Can be bonsai-ed in pots.
- \$55 **BAMBUSA VULGARIS cv. 'WAMIN STRIATED' (Striated Buddha's Belly)**. China. 5m x 12cm. -2°C. As above but with light and dark green striped culms.
- \$66 **CEPHALOSTACHYUM PERGRACILE**. Asia. 6m x 5cm. -2°C. Erect branch free lower part, beautiful ornamental.
- \$55 **DENDROCALAMOPSIS VALIDUS**. China. 12m x 8cm. -2°C. Produces high quality timber and edible shoots.
- \$44 **DENDROCALAMOPSIS VARIO STRIATA**. China. 5m x 4cm. -2°C. A nice, dense, garden bamboo with unusual fernlike leaves.
- \$33 **DENDROCALAMUS ASPER (INDONESIAN CLONE)**. Indonesia. 30m x 30cm. -5°C. A magnificent looking bamboo with many uses. Its enormous, straight culms are covered in velvet like hair. Grown commercially for timber and edible shoots.
- \$33 **DENDROCALAMUS ASPER (THAI CLONE)**. Thailand. 30m x 30cm. -5°C. This clone flowered recently and plants today vary enormously.
- \$66 **DENDROCALAMUS ASPER cv. 'BETUNG HITAM' (Black Asper)**. Indonesia. 30m x 30cm. -5°C. This black culmed giant produces valuable timber and has the best growth rate of all the big bamboos. Edible. A must have if you've got the space.
- \$33 **DENDROCALAMUS BRANDISII**. India. 36m x 20cm. -4°C. Tallest bamboo in the world. It's thick walled culms makes good timber, edible.
- \$55 **DENDROCALAMUS BRANDISII var. 'BLACK' (Black Brandisii)**. As above with green culms that turn black with age. A vigorous bamboo.
- \$55 **DENDROCALAMUS BRANDISII var. 'VARIEGATED'**. As above but has cream/yellow variegated leaves.
- \$33 **DENDROCALAMUS BRANDISII var. 'STRIATED'**. Also known as Maroochy. As above but with yellow striated culms.
- \$88 **DENDROCALAMUS GIGANTEUS (Giant Bamboo)**. Burma. 30m x 30cm. -2°C. Largest in the world, quality timber and shoots.
- \$33 **DENDROCALAMUS LATIFLORUS**. China. 25m x 20cm. -4°C. Grown commercially for its edible shoots and excellent timber.
- \$55 **DENDROCALAMUS LATIFLORUS cv. 'MEI NUNG'**. China. 24m x 20cm. -4°C. Light green culms striped with darker green and large leaves with occasional yellow stripes. A magnificent ornamental with good timber and edible shoots.

- \$33 **DENDROCALAMUS MEMBRANACEUS**. Burma. 10m x 10cm. -4°C. Edible shoots. Looks great with its weeping culms. Open clumping.
- \$55 **DENDROCALAMUS MINOR var. AMOENUS (Ghost Bamboo)**. China. 8m x 5cm. -2°C. White powder covered lime-green culms with dark green striations. Very beautiful feature plant.
- \$22 **DENDROCALAMUS SIKKIMENSIS**. India 20m x 15cm. -2°C. An outstanding bamboo with orange coloured culms. Produces excellent quality, straight timber suitable for construction or furniture making. Edible shoots. Seedlings also available from \$5 each.
- \$22 **DENDROCALAMUS STRICTUS (Culcutta Bamboo)**. India. 10m x 8cm. -5°C. Near solid culms and edible shoots. India's major source for paper pulp and woodchip.
- \$55 **GIGANTOCHLOA ALBOCILIATA**. Burma. 6m x 4cm. -2°C. Green culms with white stripes and arching tops reaching to the ground.
- \$66 **GIGANTOCHLOA ATROVIOLACEA (Java Black)**. Indonesia. 16m x 10cm. -2°C. This one is the best 'Black Bamboo'. Makes a great feature plant. Erect, sooty black culms with green stripes. Excellent quality timber which retains the black colour after harvesting.
- \$66 **GIGANTOCHLOA ATROVIOLACEA var. 'WATUPAWAN'**. Indonesia. 16m x 10cm. -2°C. A fast growing bamboo with straight green culms and black striation. (Java black in reverse). Good timber.
- \$33 **GIGANTOCHLOA ATTER**. Indonesia. 20m x 15cm. -2°C. A fast grower that produces straight, good quality timber. Edible shoots.
- \$55 **GIGANTOCHLOA ATTER 'PRING LEGI'**. Indonesia. 25mx 10cm. -2°C. Green with yellow stripes. Good timber, edible shoots.
- \$33 **GIGANTOCHLOA APUS (Tabashir Bamboo)**. Malaysia. 20m x 10cm. -2°C. Excellent timber, used for furniture.
- \$66 **GIGANTOCHLOA 'AWI TEMEN'**. Indonesia. 18m x 12cm. -2°C. Erect green culms with cream stripes. Good timber.
- \$22 **GIGANTOCHLOA G57**. Indonesia. 8m x 5cm. -2°C. A good, fast growing screening bamboo. Good timber.
- \$22 **GIGANTOCHLOA HASKARLIANA**. Indonesia. 6m x 4cm -2°C. A fast growing bamboo with straight green culms and weeping tops. The lush, dense foliage makes this one a great two-storey screener.
- \$33 **GIGANTOCHLOA HITAM HIJAU**. Sumatra. 5m x 4cm -2°C. Hitam Hijau means black and green. Beautiful garden ornamental with dark green culms and weeping tops. Excellent medium sized feature bamboo.
- \$22 **GIGANTOCHLOA LEVIS**. Philippines. 20m x 18cm. -2°C. A beautiful ornamental with good timber and edible shoots.
- \$22 **GIGANTOCHLOA LUTEOSTRIATA (Syn. G. South Kalimantan)**. Indonesia. 5m x 3cm. -2°C. A beautiful garden bamboo with dark green culms and large cream striped leaves. Tight clumping with weeping tops. An excellent privacy and windbreak plant.
- \$22 **GIGANTOCHLOA MANGGONG**. Indonesia. 10m x 7cm. -2°C. This quite rare one has large leaves and a branch free lower part.
- \$22 **GIGANTOCHLOA NIGROCILIATA (Black Hair Bamboo)**. Indonesia. 5m x 3cm. -3°C. A nice upright green ornamental.
- \$55 **GIGANTOCHLOA sp. PANJANG**. Sumatra. 6m x 4cm. -2°C. A small, green bamboo for the garden. Occasional white stripes on basal nodes.
- \$55 **GIGANTOCHLOA PARING MINYAK**. Indonesia. 25m x 10cm. -2°C This large upright bamboo is used in building water platforms and rafts.
- \$44 **GIGANTOCHLOA PSEUDOARUNDINACEA var. 'GOMBONG BATU'**. Indonesia. 30m x 12cm. -2°C. A vigorous grower which produces first grade timber and edible shoots. Straight, slightly rough, cream striped culms. The futures no.1 commercial bamboo. A beautiful plant.
- \$44 **GIGANTOCHLOA PSEUDOARUNDINACEA var. 'MAXIMA'**. SE Asia. 30m x 12cm. -2°C. This giant has edible shoots and its smooth, green, cream striped culms are commonly used for building.
- \$44 **GIGANTOCHLOA PSEUDOARUNDINACEA var. 'AWI GOMBONG'**. Indonesia. 30m x 12cm. -2°C. As above but with rougher upper internodes.
- \$22 **GIGANTOCHLOA sp. 'RACHEL CARSON'**. Indonesia. 8m x 6cm. -2°C. A straight, large leafed bamboo with cream striated culms. A beautiful plant with edible shoots and good timber.
- \$33 **GIGANTOCHLOA RIDLEYI**. Indonesia? 18m x 10cm. A medium sized bamboo. Green culms with yellow striation. Good straight timber.
- \$44 **GIGANTOCHLOA ROBUSTA**. Indonesia. 20m x 10cm. -2°C. Erect yellow/cream striated culms, large leaves. Good timber and shoots.
- \$33 **GIGANTOCHLOA TIYING PAPAII**. Bali. 10m x 5cm. -2°C. Green culms surrounded by cream striation. Large leaves and upright culms.
- \$22 **GIGANTOCHLOA WRAYII**. Malaysia. 6m x 5cm. -2°C. Nice looking and upright, used for handicraft. Good privacy and windbreak plant.
- \$77 **GUADUA AMPLEXIFOLIA**. South America. 18mx 10cm. -2°C. A useful bamboo similar to Angustifolia but smaller.
- \$55 **GUADUA ANGUSTIFOLIA**. S America. 25m x 15cm. -2°C. This structural bamboo is said to be insect and rot proof for up to forty years. Straight, strong and thick walled. Open clumping. Very beautiful but also very thorny.
- \$110 **GUADUA ANGUSTIFOLIA BICOLOUR**. S America. 25m x 15cm. -2°C As above but culms have yellow striations.
- \$55 **HIMALAYACALAMUS PORCATUS (Nepalese Blue)**. Nepal. 3m x 1cm. -10°C. Delicate looking with fine leaves. Prefers cooler climates.
- \$88 **MELLOCANUS BACCIFERA (Berry Bamboo)**. India. 8m x 7cm. -3°C. Open clumping. Both shoots and a pear like seed are edible.
- \$55 **NASTUS ELATUS**. New Guinea. 20m x 10cm. -2°C. Beautiful light green culms that age to almost black. Edible shoots. Likes well drained soil.
- \$110 **NEOLOLEBA ATRA. (Iron Range Bamboo)**. Australia. 5m x 3cm. 0°C. Formerly known as Bambusa Forbesii. This beautiful native bamboo finally got its right classification. Tight clumping with large leaves. Prefers some shade. Makes a beautiful pot plant.
- \$55 **OTATEA ACUMINATA AZTECORUM (Mexican Weeping)**. Mexico. 6m x 3cm. -9°C. Small thin leaves on slender culms.
- \$33 **SCHIZOSTACHYUM sp. 'BAMBU ERATEN'**. Java. 5m x 4cm. -2°C. A nice bushy bamboo with large leaves, used for flute making.
- \$33 **SCHIZOSTACHYUM BRACHYCLADUM 'YELLOW' (Sacred Bamboo)**. SE Asia. 15m x 7cm. -2°C. Thin walled, erect yellow culms with green stripes and large yellow striped leaves. Very beautiful. Used for craft, wind chimes, musical instruments, etc.
- \$22 **SCHIZOSTACHYUM BRACHYCLADUM 'GREEN'**. As above but with plain green culms.
- \$44 **SCHIZOSTACHYUM DUMETORUM**. S.E. Asia. 5m x 1cm. -2°C. Forms an extremely weeping bush about 2m high.
- \$33 **SCHIZOSTACHYUM GLAUCIFOLIUM (Lima)**. New Guinea. 20m x 10cm. -2°C. Thin walled beauty with yellow culms and green stripes.
- \$77 **SCHIZOSTACHYUM HAINANENSIS**. China. 8m x 4cm. -2°C. Green culms with slender weeping tops. A very beautiful feature plant.
- \$22 **SCHIZOSTACHYUM JACULANS**. SE Asia. 8m x 3cm. -2°C. Ornamental, tight clumping with long internodes, branch-free lower half.
- \$33 **SCHIZOSTACHYUM sp. 'KLUANG SUPAT'** Sumatra. 2m x 1.5cm. -2°C. A small garden bamboo that needs shade. Good pot plant.
- \$33 **SCHIZOSTACHYUM LUMAMPAO**. Philippines. 15m x 7cm. -2°C. A beautiful ornamental, thin walled and straight.
- \$22 **SCHIZOSTACHYUM sp 'MURRAY ISLAND'**. Australia. 5m x 2.5cm. -2°C. Tight clumping and erect with branchless lower section. Great screening / hedge bamboo and beautiful feature when planted up against a fence.
- \$22 **SCHIZOSTACHYUM sp. 'TAMIANG'**. Java. 4m x 3cm. -2°C. A nice ornamental suitable for the small suburban garden. Upright culms with a bushy habit. Good screening or hedge bamboo.
- \$22 **SCHIZOSTACHYUM ZOLLINGERI**. SE Asia. 5m x 3cm. -2°C. A nice, tight clumping garden plant with straight culms, branch free lower part and nodding tops, useful timber and edible shoots.
- \$55 **THAMNOCALAMUS SPATHACEUS**. China. 5m x 2cm. -20°C. Fountain shaped, fine leafed ornamental. Needs shade. Good indoor pot plant.
- \$55 **THYROSTACHYS SIAMENSIS (Clone I) (Monastery Bamboo)**. Thailand. 6m x 3cm. -4°C. Tight clumping ornamental with slightly weeping culms, very fine leaves and edible shoots. The solid or near solid culms makes it a good timber bamboo.
- \$55 **THYROSTACHYS SIAMENSIS (Clone II)**. Thailand. 13m x 6cm. -4°C. As above but larger and more erect.

Prices quoted are in 4 or 6 litre bags. Some species also available in 10 and 25 litre bags. Prices subject to change.
